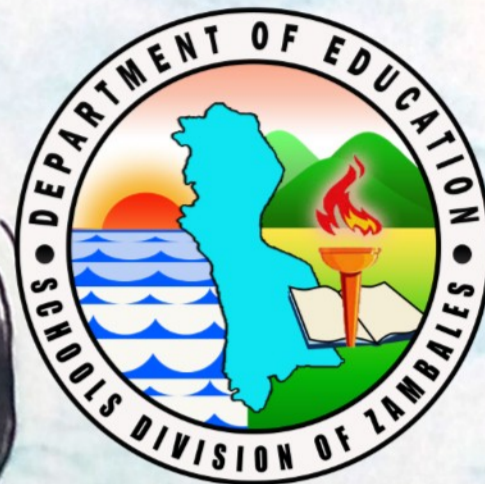

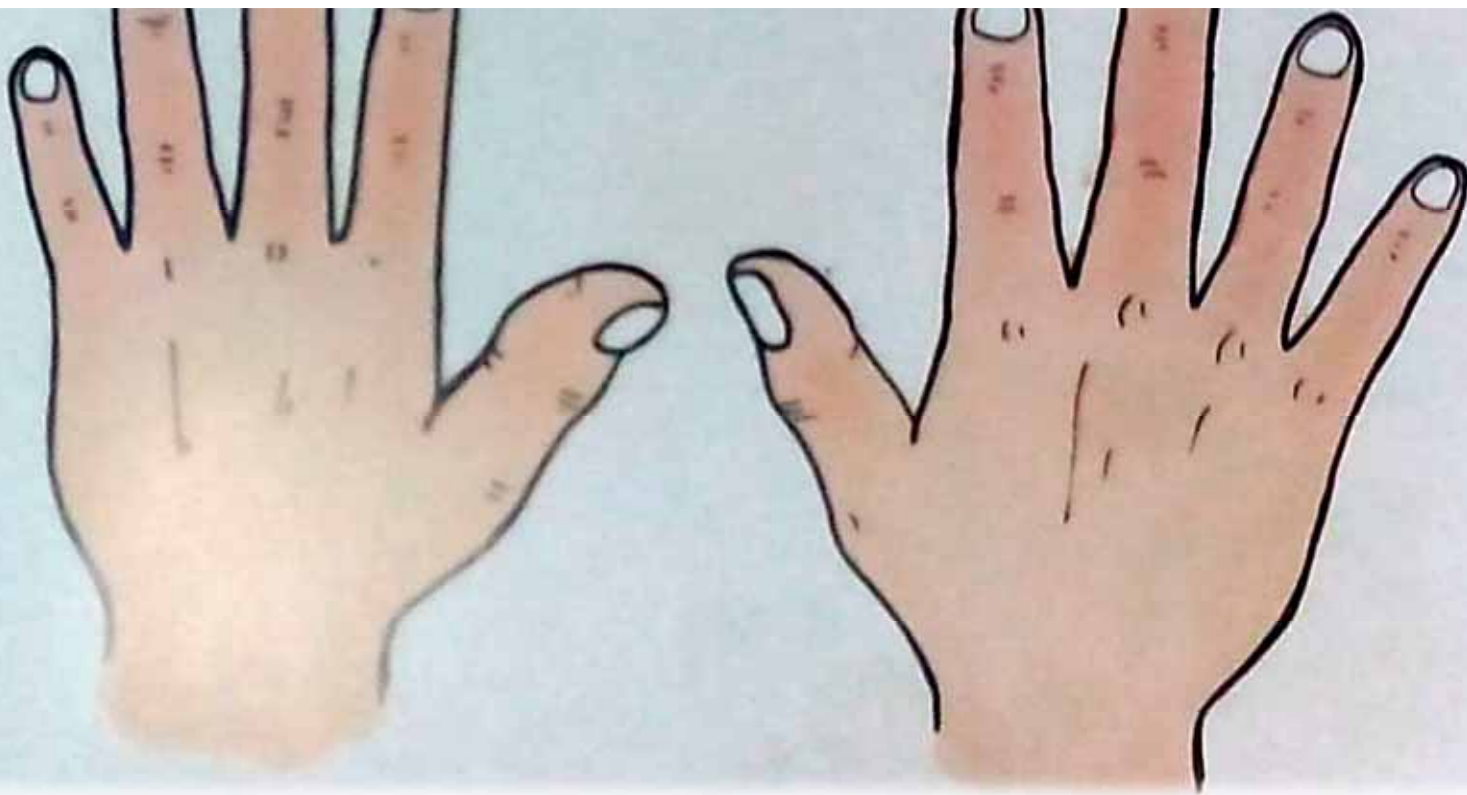

**“Labay-labay kon daepen ya baw- bolaklak. Hmmmmm kaw- kabangohan la.”**

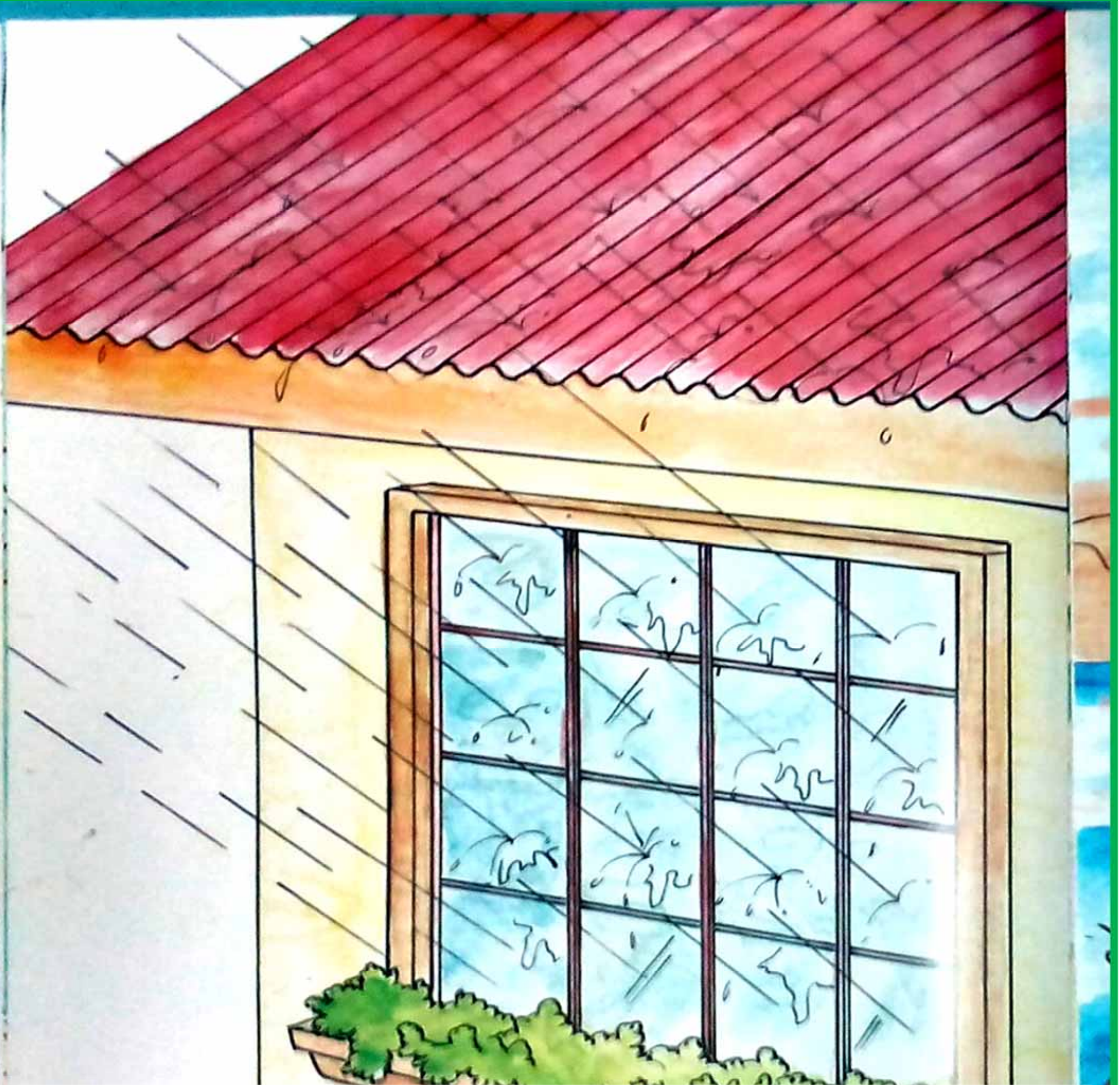
**“I love to smell the flowers. Hmm... the flowers are as fragrant as can be.”**

**“I love to touch my three pets Pussy, Brownie and Bunny.”**

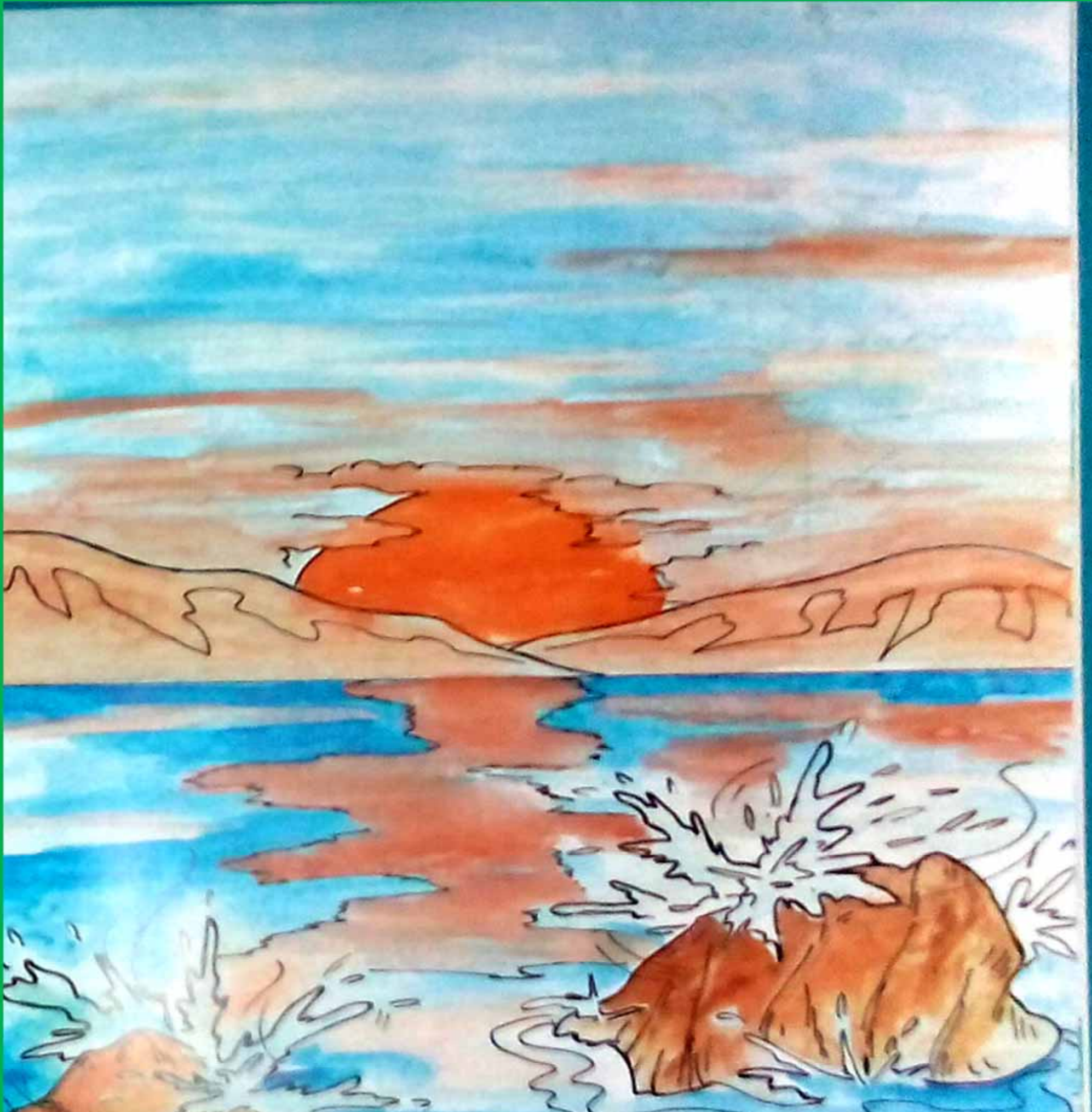




**“Labay-labay kon leng-en ya tonoy nin uran ha bobong boy dorwangan”.**

Hear them buzz, buzz, buzz, buzz, buzz.”**

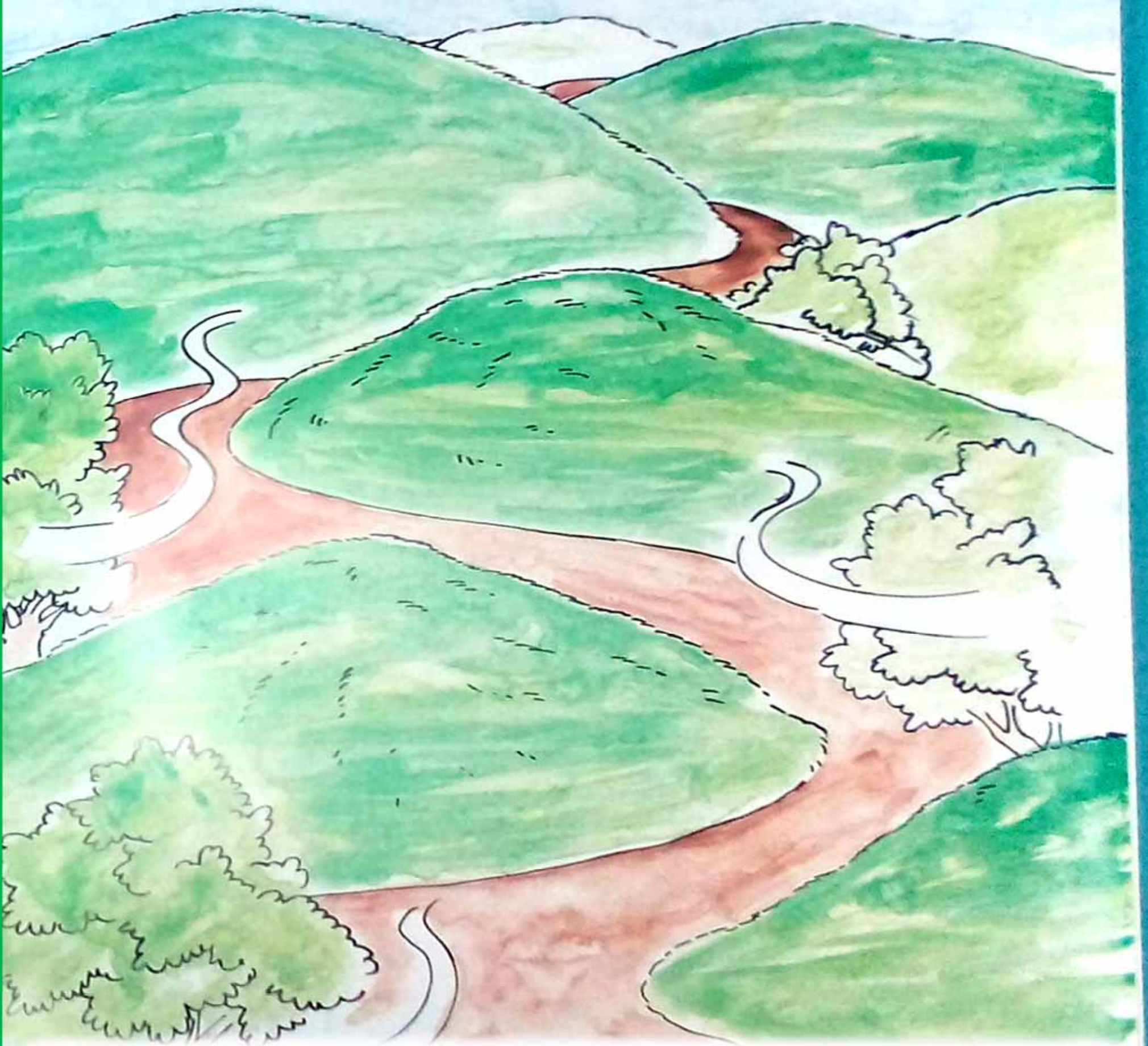


**“ Labay- labay kon tomangoy ha malay-ep boy asol ya lanom.  
Labay-labay kon mipopowayo ha liglig nin ambay”.**



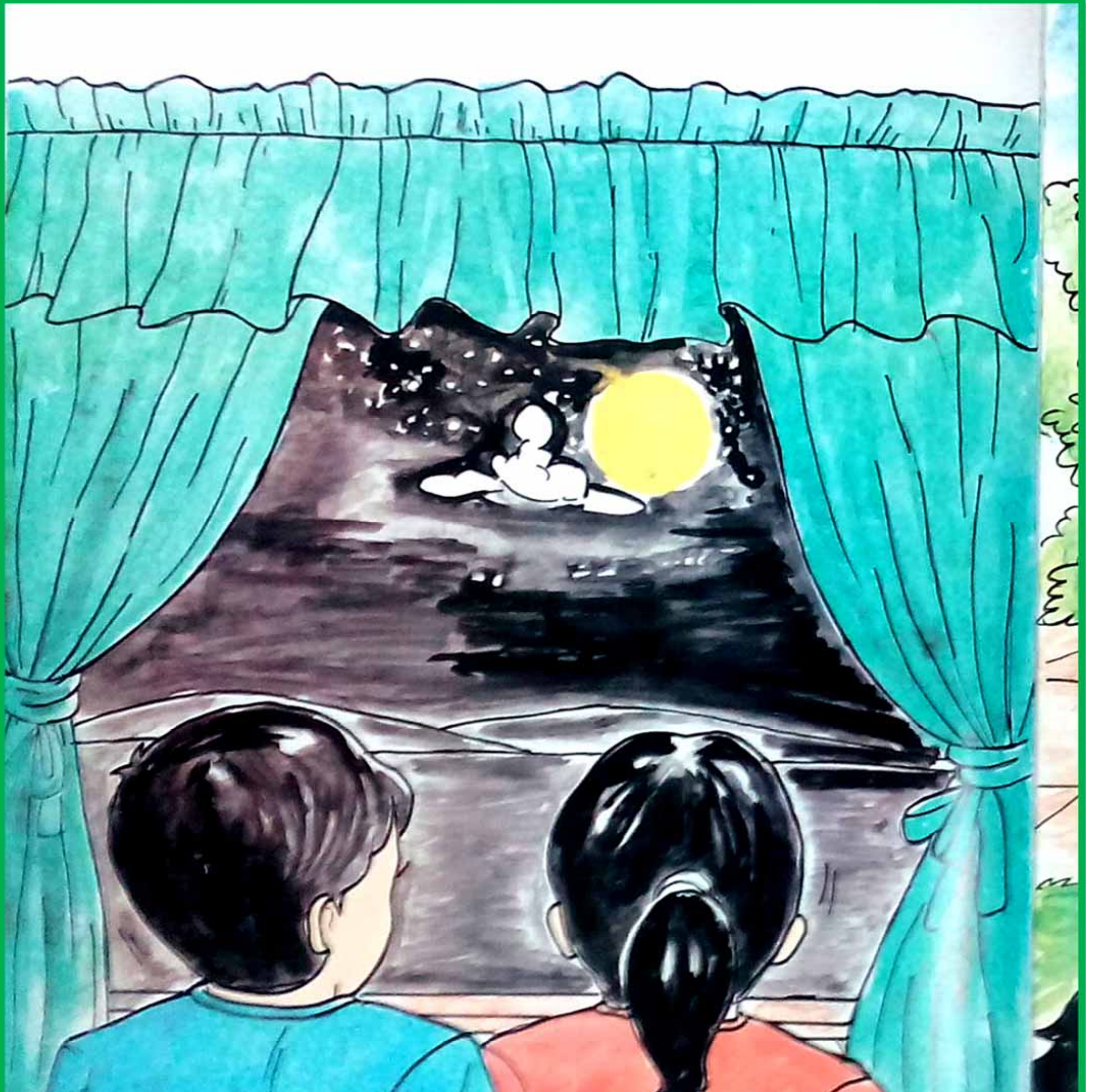
**“I love to swim in the cool blue waters.

**“I love to climb the hills. They’re so grassy, cool and green.”**

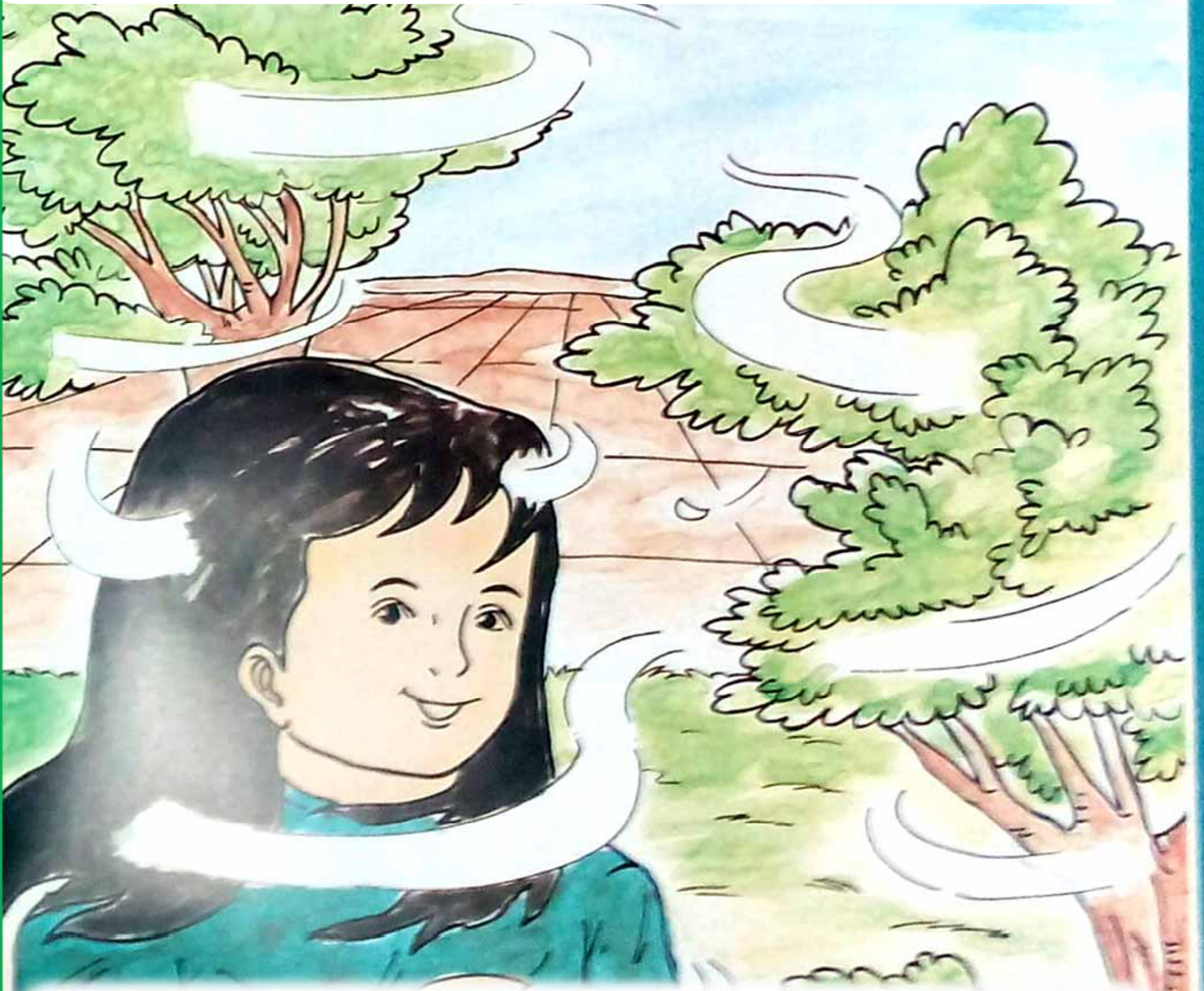




**“ Labay- labay kon patagen ya mahawang ya bowan ha mareg-lem ya yabi.”**

**“I love to see the moon as it shines brightly in the dark sky at night.”**

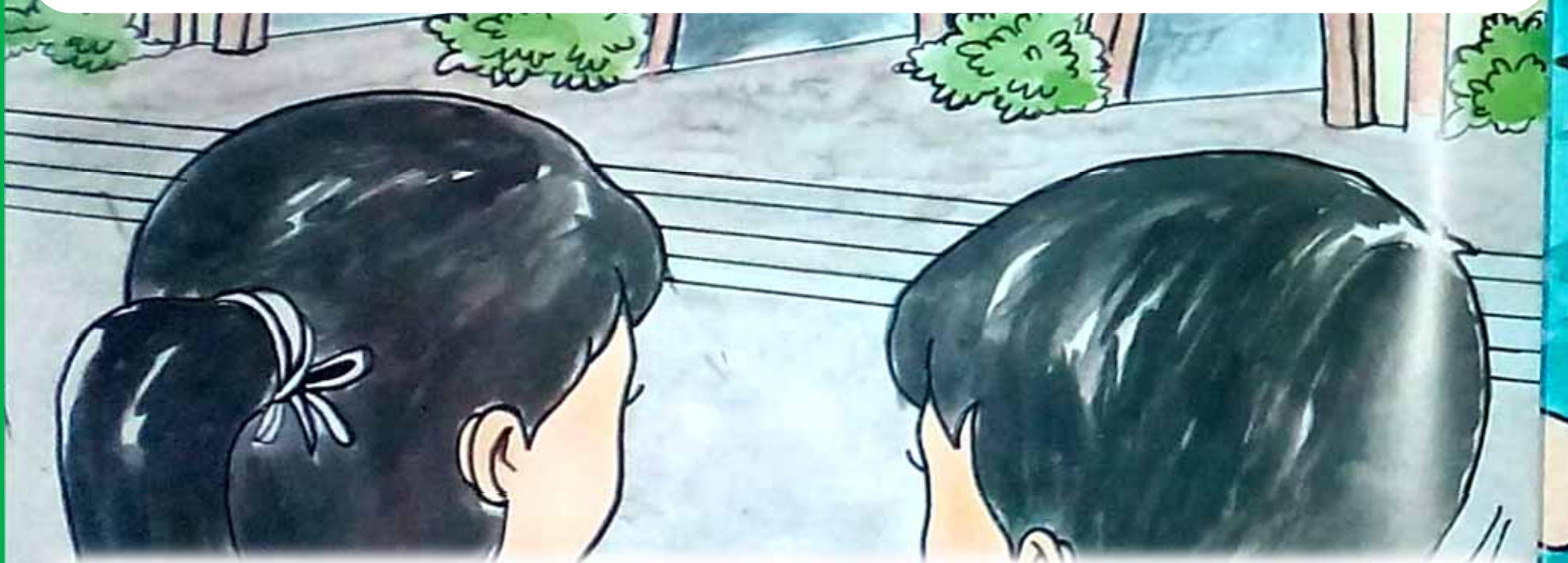
**“ Labay- labay kon matanam ya manawa’y payhep
